UITP PRESENTS ITS PRIORITIES FOR EU POLICY

Brussels, 5 November 2019

Following the success of our <u>MobilityOnTop! campaign</u>, UITP is now presenting concrete actions to implement the <u>EU Mobility Manifesto</u> and achieve a modal shift to sustainable public transport.

By creating <u>a list of concrete actions</u>, UITP will help **EU decision makers** improve **mobility** and the **quality of daily life** for all European citizens by achieving a modal shift to **sustainable public transport**.

UITP is now calling on EU decision makers to translate these priorities into concrete actions and to recognise the **major role public transport plays in our lives and cities**.

This list of actions is based on the **four priorities** identified in our **Mobility Manifesto** <u>launched in</u> <u>February ahead of the European elections</u>.

The campaign has been a great success, as we have received the support of more than 300 signatures, including almost 40 MEPs.

The **European Committee of the Regions** were the latest to endorse the campaign, when CoR President Karl-Heinz **Lambert pledged his support**.

"We encourage all EU decision makers to endorse our priority to make sustainable urban public transport a key topic for the new legislature. This will not only be beneficial in terms of mobility, but it will also help reduce CO2 emissions, prevent climate change, create local jobs, empower the economy and make our cities safer and more liveable."
