The role requires **experience and leadership**, and during the most recent General Assembly (*Friday 18 June 2021*) **Khalid Alhogail, the Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director of** <u>the Saudi Public Transport Company (SAPTCO)</u>, was voted in **as UITP's new President** for the 2021-2023 term.

As CEO and MD of SAPTCO for the past 15 years, Khalid Alhogail is a well-known and respected industry figure, overseeing one of the largest public transport companies in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region.

Every two years, the candidate(s) who have put themselves forward to **become part of our Secretariat leadership** face a vote during our General Assembly.

During his tenure, Mr. Alhogail will **advocate for public transport** through a wide range of activities and opportunities, **working alongside our international membership**.

With an extensive background in the sector, Khalid Alhogail is also **the Chairman of the Saudi Emirates Integrated Transport Company (SEITCO) joint venture** between SAPTCO and Emirates Transport.

Mr Alhogail is also Chairman of the SAPTCO-RATP Dev joint venture Public Transport Company (PTC) and a board member of the RATP Dev-SAPTCO joint venture Capital Metro Company (CAMCO). Previously Chairman of the Saudi National Union for Joint Stock Companies, representing 186 CEOS of listed companies for ten years, he has been closely involved with several major transportation projects in the Middle East and North Africa and has developed many successful international projects to benefit the region.
