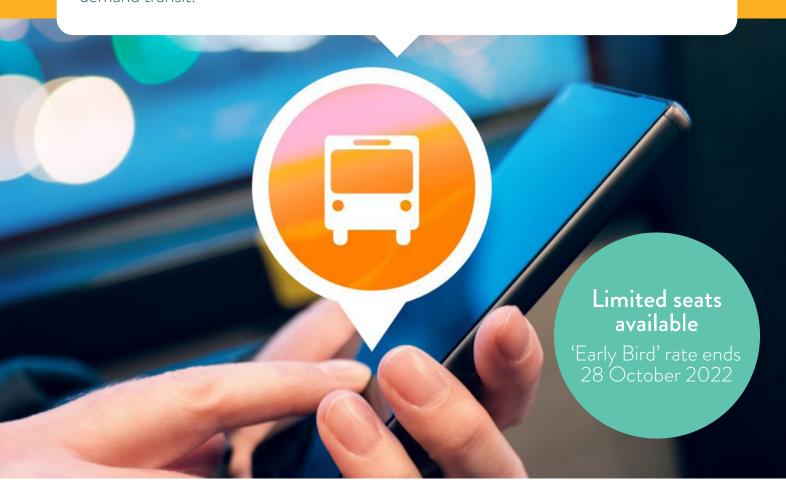
ON-DEMAND TRANSIT FOR NORTH AMERICA

Demand-responsive transit (DRT) services have existed both formally and informally for a long time. New developments in communication and sensor technology have enabled such services to grow substantially in urban, suburban and rural areas.

As a technology-driven share transport service it operates with flexible schedules and stops, and/or flexible routing. Its key differences with traditional public transport is that services are provided in direct response to the demand from customers.

This is useful where the cost of the fixed route or the fixed route schedule service is unusually high in proportion to the demand such as in sparsely populated areas or during random times of the day. It also useful in first/last mile connectivity.

This training will contextualize multiple ways of delivering on-demand ridesharing through a combination of theoretical and practical frameworks. Participants will have a better understanding of best practices, tools, skills and solutions needed to implement a similar framework for their organisation and cities.
