A SMART INVESTMENT	Public transport contributes €130–150 billion annually to the EU economy, representing 1–1.2% of the EU's GDP, and every euro invested generates a five-to-one economic return.
A CLIMATE AND HEALTH SOLUTION	Doubling public transport use would halve transport-related urban CO₂ emissions and air pollution.
A SERVICE FOR ALL EUROPEANS	Urban and regional public transport enables more than 60 billion passenger journeys annually (60 times more journeys than air travel).
A EUROPEAN JOB ENGINE	The sector supports over 3 million jobs in operations, maintenance, and vehicle manufacturing.
